There are two ways to end your participation in AgriStability:


- When you receive your Enrolment/Fee Notice for the upcoming program year, use
 the appropriate check box to indicate you no longer want to participate in the
 Program. Submit the tear-off portion to SCIC by the deadline indicated on the
 Enrolment/Fee Notice.
 - Please note, if you do not notify SCIC by the Enrolment/Fee Notice deadline, you will be required to pay the Administrative Cost Share, and any applicable program fees and penalties for that program year. It is your responsibility to notify SCIC by the applicable deadlines if you would like to rejoin the program in the future.
- You can also withdraw participation in AgriStability by completing the Cancel Participation form. You must complete and return the cancellation form by the applicable deadline. Otherwise, you will be required to pay the Administrative Cost Share, and any applicable program fees and penalties for that program year.
