Crop Inventory Calculation Worksheet Instruction Guide








How to Complete Your Crop Inventory Calculation Worksheet

The Crop Inventory Calculation Worksheet can be used to help report the changes in crop inventory that have occurred in the farming operation during the fiscal year. The worksheet can be submitted with your AgriStability forms to assist with processing the file.

- 1 Your SCIC ID and AgriStability PIN are different numbers. The AgriStability PIN is generated by the Federal Government for AgriStability and AgriInvest purposes, whereas the SCIC ID is unique to your Saskatchewan Crop Insurance account.
 - **Note**: Crop Insurance contract numbers are not to be used as either the SCIC ID or AgriStability PIN.
- 2 Enter the applicable commodity code for the inventory you are reporting. Access the current Commodity Code Guide at scic.ca/agristability/publications or call SCIC at 1–866–270–8450 for assistance.
- 3 Report the crop or forage (including grade) with the expectation to be harvested for the program year. Please be specific with the type of grain and grade (e.g., Instead of simply reporting "wheat," please report as either "Durum" or "CWRS wheat" and the applicable grade.)
- 4 Enter the code for the unit of measurement used to measure the commodity you are reporting. Commodities must be reported using units of measurement, not dollars.

Code 1 – Pounds, Code 2 – Tonnes, Code 4 – Bushels, Code 5 – Kilograms, Code 7 – Small Bales, Code 8 – Large Bales, Code 10 – Litres, Code 11 – Gallons, Code 16 – CWT. Code 64 – Other.



- 5 Indicate the number of acres used to produce each crop. List only those acres for crops that produced or should have produced a crop during the program year. For commodities not measured in acres, use the unit of measurement considered standard for that commodity.
- 6 Enter carry over inventory that is on hand at the start of your fiscal year (e.g., if your fiscal year is January 1 to December 31, enter what was in inventory as of December 31 in the prior year).
- 7 Indicate the quantity produced in the fiscal year using the same unit of measurement reported in column C.
- 8 Indicate the quantity purchased to be used as seed, using the same unit of measurement reported in column C. Include only seed purchased and used in this program year. This does not include seed purchased with the intent to re-sell or to be used next year.
- 9 Report the quantity sold in the fiscal year, using the same unit of measurement reported in column C. Do not include deferred amounts from the prior year.
- 10 Indicate the quantity used as feed in the fiscal year, using the same unit of measurement reported in column C.
- Indicate the quantity used as seed in the fiscal year, using the same unit of measurement reported in column C.
- 12 Indicate your inventory at the end of your fiscal year.

 Do not include inputs purchased in this fiscal year with the intent to be used next year.
- Report the average price received throughout the year for the commodity.


