General Information

There are two ways to end your participation in AgriStability:


- 1. When you receive your Enrolment/Fee Notice for the upcoming program year, use the appropriate check box to indicate that you do not want to participate and submit the tear-off portion by the deadline indicated on the Enrolment/Fee Notice to SCIC. Please note, if you do not notify SCIC by the Enrolment/Fee Notice deadline, you will be required to pay the Administrative Cost Share, and any applicable program fees and penalties for that program year. It is your responsibility to notify SCIC by the applicable deadlines if you would like to rejoin the program in the future.
- You can also end participation in AgriStability by completing the Cancel Participation form. You must complete and return the cancellation form by the applicable deadline. Otherwise, you will be required to pay the Administrative Cost Share, and any applicable program fees and penalties for that program year. The Cancel Participation form is available online at https://www.scic.ca/agristability/forms

When completing the Cancel Participation form, please complete the follow:

1. Enter your SCIC ID and AgriStability PIN on the top right-hand side of the form.



2. Fill in the Participant Information section of the form









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3. Select one of the two options to cancel and provide the reason for cancelling.

4. The producer or signing officer, if it is for a corporation, must sign and date the form and submit it to SCIC. A contact person cannot sign this form on behalf of their client, it must be signed the producer or signing officer.
